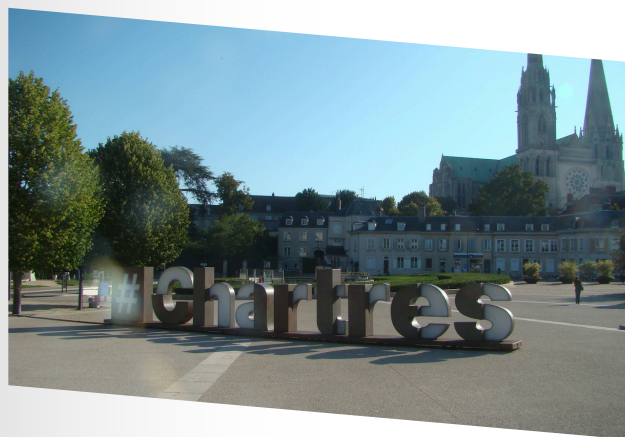

## The IFSanté Chartres

The Nursing Institute of Chartres depends on Tours university.

There are 105 nursing students per class, 65 nursing auxiliaries, and 20 paramedics.

We are :  
18 teachers,  
a director,  
an educational coordinator,  
a librarian,  
4 secretaries,  
2 IT referent.

## Goals

The students will discover different European health systems, practice English language and acquire new skills.

They will also aim to become familiar with different technical treatments and patient-nurse relationship, to enrich their practice and to open to other ways of practising nursing.

During the internship, students must validate skills and must be supervised by qualified nurses.

## Alternating current internship

The students' training is organized:

- In the hospital of Chartres
- In retirement homes
- In psychiatric hospitals
- With free-lance nurses as well as with permanent nursing staff.

The students divide their time between classes and internship.

The nursing students are required to do their internship in at least four of the following areas:

- In the acute care sector
- In the mental health care and psychiatry
- In the individual or collective Care living areas
- In the long-term care, subacute care and rehabilitation.
